MTB Easy tour visiting chestnut groves and open-air art.

If you want a tour that's not overly long or strenuous, but is still interesting and varied, this one's for you. Start in Arco and head towards San Martino, initially along a mountain road, afterwards on concrete and gravel paths up to the hamlet of Carobbi, an idyllically situated farmstead surrounded by mighty chestnuts. Forest tracks then lead down to the picturesque village of Braila and along a tarmac road to the Open Air Gallery, where you can admire unique works of art and sculptures by various artists. You then descend via Drena, past the imposing castle and into Valle del Sarca. Keeping to the south-eastern side of the valley, you alternate between tarmac and gravel and cycle through flat orchards and vineyards back to the starting point in Arco.

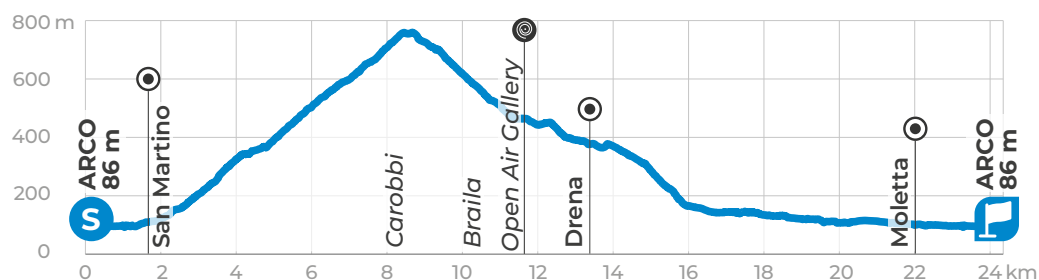
